Course Title: Critical Approaches to Literature

Course description: This course will examine a number of critical approaches to literature that have deeply affected the way we study literature in the classroom and the way we approach texts. We will begin with a careful consideration of the New Criticism before proceeding to examine critical approaches to literature that challenged the premises of New Criticism, including a variety of feminist and Marxist approaches, Postcolonial Theory, Queer Theory, and Postmodernist criticism.

**Required Reading:** The Norton Anthology of Theory and Criticism, Second Edition.

**First Three Texts/Authors to be Studied:** T. S. Eliot, Wimsatt and Beardsley, Brooks.

Method of Instruction: Lecture and Discussion.

**Method of Evaluation:** Two short theoretical position papers: 20% each; Midterm Test: 15%; Final Exam: 35%; Participation: 10%.
