

## CPS Departmental Application Process for Undergraduate Research Awards

The following outlines the application process for the NSERC USRA and UTEA research awards with the Department of Chemicals & Physical Sciences. **Only one application is required** and your application will be put forward for all applicable awards.

**Only submit the requested documents.** Selected students will be informed of the next steps once the department has reviewed all applications.

### Step 1: Eligibility

You are eligible to apply if all of the following applies to you:

- Registered either full-time or part-time at the time of application;
- CGPA of at least B- or better.
- Cannot be currently registered or have been previously registered, in a graduate program in the same field of study.
- You cannot have completed all your degree requirements.

#### **For NSERC USRA:**

- You are a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada.

**Important Note for UTEA:** While only Canadian citizens and permanent residents are eligible for NSERC USRA, we encourage non-residents to apply as well as you may be eligible for the University of Toronto Excellence Award (UTEA), a very similar U of T fellowship without the citizenship/permanent residency requirement.

### Step 2: Propose Supervisor Choices

You are **required** to list two supervisor that you wish to work with, ranking them as your first and second choice. You need to talk to your first choice of supervisor before you put their name down, and you are strongly encouraged to also talk to your second choice supervisor.

If you only provide one choice, your application will be disqualified. You are strongly encouraged to select professors in different CPS disciplines (astronomy, chemistry, earth science, and physics).

### Step 3: Submit Your Informal Statement of Interest

The following must be emailed (PDF or Word format) to the CPS Undergraduate Administrative Assistant, Eliza Escandar, at [cpsug.utm@utoronto.ca](mailto:cpsug.utm@utoronto.ca), by the deadline listed on our website.

- a) A page titled, "Application for an NSERC USRA with CPS" with your name, institution, student number, and your first and second choices for your supervisor (professors in CPS). If applicable, state your indigenous or non-residency status.

**Note 1:** Your supervisor is selected from your two listed choices by the Awards Committee.

- b) You are strongly encouraged to include a CV or resume, especially if you have science-related extracurricular experiences or previous research experiences.
