Toronto's own Narendra Datar presents a lecture demonstration on the modal and rhythmic structures of North Indian classical music, followed by a performance of classical, semi-classical, and devotional pieces.

Narendra Datar began his formal musical training at the age of sixteen under Agra gharana vocalist Pandit Vasant Rao Kulkarni. Since 1986, he has been active in Toronto as a teacher, performer, and composer. He is a recipient of the Shastri Indo-Canadian Institute Senior Performing Arts Fellowship.
