Peter Cole is the author of four books of poems, most recently *Things on Which I've Stumbled* (New Directions). His many volumes of translations from Hebrew and Arabic include *The Poetry of Kabbalah: Mystical Verse from the Jewish Tradition* (Yale) and *The Dream of the Poem: Hebrew Poetry from Muslim and Christian Spain, 950-1492* (Princeton). Cole has

received numerous honors for his work, including a Guggenheim Fellowship, the PEN Translation Award for Poetry, and an Award in Literature from the American Academy of Arts and Letters. He was named a MacArthur Fellow in 2007. He teaches at Yale.
