Program Information & Curriculum

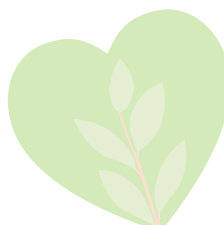

SUMMER INTERNSHIP/CO-OP DETAILS

The MScSM Program's summer work term enables an employer to hire a graduate student for a wide range of projects. Suitable internship or co-op placements should:

- Run between May and August
- Be full-time for a minimum of 10-16 weeks in duration
- Be comprised of work suitable for a graduate-level student
- Offer sufficient supervision and mentoring
- Be paid*

*Based on approval, employers are eligible for the Cooperative Education Tax Credit incentive program, and may claim up to \$3,000 in credit.

Sample Projects & Placements

- Analyze the sustainability practices at an organization and create reports and recommendations
- Identify best practices and assess performance against industry benchmarks
- Produce research findings and produce presentations on corporate performance directives
- Create marketing or public relations campaigns around sustainability practices and policies
- Contribute to projects relating to operations, supply chain, finance, human resources, marketing, and more.
