

## The Anatomy of the Matrix Note-taking System

Summarize the lecture's key ideas and make comparisons and connections. Use the Matrix note-taking system after lecture to do this. It neatly organizes information and highlights what you need to know.

The Matrix system:

- Easy to read
- Summarizes key information
- Shows connections and comparisons between different concepts
- Can be hard to use during lectures

### How it works

#### 1. Organize the information using headings

Create tables or charts to separate information under different headings.

#### 2. Design your tables to highlight comparisons and connections

You don't have to make everything a T-table. Consider making a 2 x 2 table to highlight the features of two groups within two traits.
